As you will be aware, *Twitter* is a social networking and micro-blogging service that allows you to send out short messages called 'tweets'. Tweets are limited to 140 characters but can contain media like photos or videos.

This is another flow of communication to you as parents and carers and will be used for a number of things including news and events, important information and sharing success in school.

We also aim to create polls – Twitter is a great way to get feedback from our parents.

*Twitter* is not designed for children under 13 to use and the children will not be allowed to tweet in school. Only the children's first names will be posted on the site as a matter of safeguarding. e.g. Henry in Y1; Jack L in Y5

Our *Twitter* feed will be embedded into the homepage of our new website launching on 1 March 2019. For pupils there can be a real sense of achievement when they see their work celebrated online and equally for parents it will be lovely to read for example that your child received a 'special mention' in Friday assembly.
