## Other

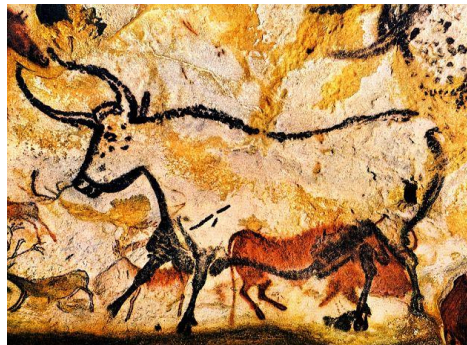
- Swimming will continue every Wednesday.
