Dear Parents and Carers,

Coronavirus: provision for key workers

If your work is critical to the COVID-19 response, or you work in one of the critical sectors listed below, and you cannot keep your child safe at home then your children will be prioritised for education provision.

Our provision will be run with a skeleton staff between the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm.

We will not be in a position to provide lunch initially during week commencing 23 March 2020 other than for children who are in receipt of Free School Meals, so children will need a packed lunch. Children should wear play clothes and trainers. Ideally they should also bring wellies and a coat.

Please note that this service is to cover your work duties only and that we do require confirmation from your employer that you will be playing a critical role in the response to COVID-19. As per the guidance, *if workers think they fall within the critical categories above they should confirm with their employer that, based on their business continuity arrangements, their specific role is necessary for the continuation of this essential public service.*
