Consultation on Proposed Change to Published Admission Number (PAN) for Nanstallon CP School

The Governing Board of Nanstallon CP School is consulting on proposed changes to the school's admission arrangements for the academic year 2027/28.

Currently, the Published Admission Number (PAN) for Reception is 17 places. From September 2027, the Governing Board proposes to reduce the PAN to 15 places.

Rationale for the Change

This proposal is being considered in response to:

- Falling rolls locally, reflecting declining birth rates across Cornwall;
- The need to ensure sustainable class sizes and staffing structures;
- Guidance from Cornwall Council encouraging schools to align PAN with projected local demand

The reduction would enable the school to manage resources more effectively while continuing to provide high-quality education.

Who We Are Consulting

In line with statutory requirements, we are consulting with:

- Parents of children aged 2–18 in the local area;
- Cornwall Council (as the local authority);
- Governing bodies/admission authorities of neighbouring schools within a 5-mile radius;
- Other stakeholders with an interest in school admissions.

How to Respond

The consultation will run for a period of **six weeks**, from **16 October 2025** to **4 December 2025**
